Our Program

The Preschool Program provides an opportunity for children to learn new skills in preparation for school readiness. The classes include students with and without special needs. Our classrooms are located in four different elementary school sites throughout our school district. Classes meet 5 days a week and instruction is based on the Creative Curriculum® and aligns with New Jersey State and Common Core Standards. Interest areas are utilized to promote independent learning across all academic, personal, social, and developmental domains. Daily activities may include music, centers, circle time, snack, computer learning, pretend play, arts and crafts, field trips, self-care, and socialization. All activities are utilized to promote student independence.

A staff of general and special education teachers, speech and language specialists, occupational therapists, physical therapists, an assistive technology team, and paraprofessionals who provide supports to students in need of such services support the Preschool Program. A registered school nurse is also on site to address any medical concerns and perform daily nursing activities.

Parents are strongly encouraged to participate in the program and observe their child directly in the educational environment.

Q & A

Who can attend the program?

Both residents and non-residents of Wayne can attend the program. However, Wayne residents will be given priority.

Is the program offered a half-day or full day or both?

Our program is offered for half-day sessions, either morning from 8:20-10:55 or afternoon from 12:10-2:45.

How many days a week is the program offered?

Our program is offered either 3 days or 5 days.

What is the program fee?

The 3-day program costs \$207.00 per month and the 5-day program costs \$403.00 per month.

Does the program run during the summer months?

The program is currently held from September through June.
